

David Bereit started and led the 40 Days for Life movement through its first decade, building it into the largest grassroots pro-life mobilization in the world. Through its network of more than 2,000 local leaders and 750,000 volunteers in 769 cities across all 50 American states and 50 nations, 40 Days for Life has helped to save 14,643 children's lives, bring 177 workers out of the abortion industry, and close 96 abortion centers. David recently stepped away from his role as CEO of 40 Days for Life to pray, plan, and prepare for new ministry projects.

David is an internationally sought-after speaker, media spokesperson, bestselling author, and strategic advisor to many top pro-life organizations and leaders.
