- Summit 2019 – January 18th, 2019 – Falls Church, VA – Please pray for travel mercies for speakers and attendees, for God to be working through those who speak and those who listen, and that new Life ministries would be generated through this event.
- Symposium 2019 – January 25th, 2019 – San Francisco, CA – Be in prayer for more people on the west coast to join us, that churches and ministers would be interested in attending and ministering to Life, and that we the AFL staff would have energy to carry off this event after east coast events.

Please also be praying for good weather (no snowstorms or ice, please!) and for the health of everyone in the office, especially as this is prime germ and flu season.
