Through the Anglicans For Life Adoption Fund, Anglicans for Life stands as a partner in helping Anglican families in caring for orphans and vulnerable children through adoption.

Guidelines for Financial Partnership Grants

The Anglicans For Life Adoption Fund offers financial grants to help defer the cost of adoption for Anglican families in North America.

Both parents must be married and baptized Christians. The family must be actively connected to a local church affiliated with the Anglican Church in North America. Their local rector/minister/priest and church family should be in support of their adoption process and be willing to be an ongoing community of encouragement and care. A reference letter will be required from the family's local church leadership (page 4).

The family's home study or home study update must be completed and approved in order to apply.

The family must be using a placement agency (this is not referring to home study agency) that is a 501(c)3 agency licensed to place children (this cannot be an adoption consultant who is not acting as placement agency). The family will need a reference from their adoption agency (page 5).

Applications cannot be submitted for independent adoptions (through lawyers, facilitators, or humanitarian organizations not licensed to place children).

A family cannot re-apply for an adoption for which an application has already been submitted. A family is limited to one grant for each adoption.

Once an application with references is submitted, the application process is complete. An email confirmation will be sent with a date to expect a decision regarding the outcome of the application.

A review board will meet and prayerfully consider recipients of the funds based on the following: applicants' adoption story, references and prayerful leading of the Holy Spirit.

All applicants will receive a letter from the Anglicans For Life Adoption Fund regarding the outcome of their application. If a family receives a grant, they will also get instructions on how and when funds will be disbursed.

The adoption agency will also receive a copy of the grant award letter along with instructions on how they will receive funds. All funds are disbursed directly to the agency and are disbursed upon the child being placed in the family's home by the agency.
