Anglicans for Life envisions every person in every church doing one thing every day to uphold the sacredness of life.

Our mission is to empower the Church to extend God's love to people facing both beginning and end-of-life issues such as abortion, adoption, and assisted suicide. To do this, AFL has created educational, ministry, and advocacy resources to protect the vulnerable and defend the fatherless.

We know from God's Holy Scriptures that God values life, and His Word commands us to protect it. Life ministry is often misunderstood and considered optional in the Church. - Observe Sanctity of Life Sunday in your church using AFL's bulletin inserts, liturgies, and litanies

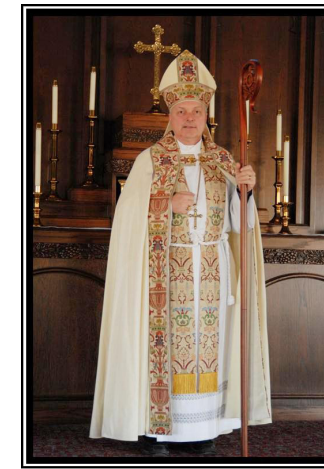

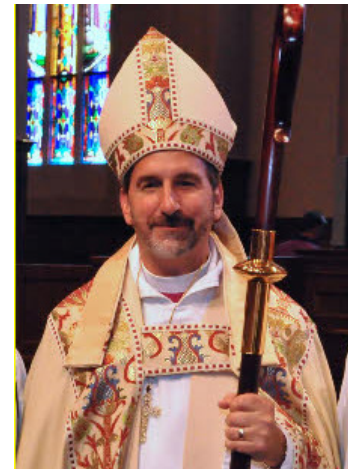
