The Gospel: John 1:1-14

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning. 3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. 4 In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. 5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

6 There was a man sent from God whose name was John. 7 He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe. 8 He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light.

9 The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world. 10 He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. 11 He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. 12 Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God— 13 children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

CONFESSION OF SIN

GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY

Heavenly Father, we acknowledge that as a nation, a church and individually we have not honored You as the Creator and Sustainer of Life. As a nation and as its citizens we have lost an appreciation for the gift of life. We repent and confess that our country has turned from Your life-giving ways by endorsing abortion, assisted suicide and research on embryos through our laws. Deliver us, and our nation, from deception and apathy as human beings are turned into commodities. Stir our hearts with a passion to protect, respect and celebrate the life of every human being, created in Your image. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

For the President of the United States and for all who advise him, that God might give them the wisdom to lead us with justice, and compassion for those who are weak, broken and defenseless; For our Senators and Congressmen that they may defend life from conception to natural death; For the members of the Supreme Court, that like Solomon, they might temper justice with compassion and proclaim by their lives a dedication to what is right and true. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

Lord, touch the hearts of those with authority who set policy, at all levels in our government to recognize their responsibility to protect and respect life. Let our nation re-commit itself to ensuring life, liberty and justice for all, born and unborn. May we be a nation under Your divine authority and always honor the sanctity of life. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

I bid your prayers for our government leaders: that they may impartially administer justice, uphold integrity and truth, restrain wickedness and vice, and maintain true righteousness.

ABORTION

We pray that as the Church defends unborn life, it may proclaim the Gospel's teaching with clarity and firmness, as a gift to a dangerously confused world. We pray that the plight of the unborn will move the hearts of all people to risk unpopularity and support these children's inalienable right to life. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

Help women who are considering abortion to heed the call of the Holy Spirit to spare the life developing in their womb, give them love and courage to give birth to their baby. Help every new mother to have faith to trust You to provide for their children. For all fathers who are fearful of fatherhood, give them a heart of compassion and courage to exercise responsibility to care for the child they have helped create and to encourage and help the woman who bears it. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

Convert the hearts of doctors, nurses, and others who provide abortion services, that their eyes will be opened to the effect of their actions. For all who support abortion, may their hearts be turned toward the unborn and their minds enlightened about the sanctity of all life. And we pray for the evangelization of our society, that we would once again see marriage as the first step in building families so no pregnancy would be unwanted or unwelcomed. Please make abortion unthinkable and unnecessary. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

We pray for the healing of women and men whose children have died by abortion: through the ministry of the Church and abortion recovery programs, may they find reconciliation with God and with themselves. Have mercy and forgive those who perform abortions. Soften their hardened hearts, and though we hate the sins you hate, give us a heart to also love as you do those persons for whom your Son died and rose. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

Let us pray for all infants who have died in abortions. May Jesus recognize them as his own and bring them to the heavenly place where peace resides. We ask you to bless and encourage ministries worldwide, who are working to protect life, especially Anglicans for Life, and Pregnancy Resource Centers who provide alternatives to abortion, that they would be strengthened in your service and bold in their witness. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

I bid your prayers for all who promote the cause of life, that not only laws, but also hearts and minds, be changed to affirm the dignity of all people.

AGING AND DEATH

May the Church treasure the lives of the aged as God treasures them, especially those who have grown old or weak or sick, that we might learn to value their wisdom and cherish their lives. Give them the protection of the law, respect from their doctors and nurses, and the abiding love of their families. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

May the families of those who are terminally ill never despair of God's goodness and never forget that the life of their loved one is always precious to Him. May all who attend the sick see in their patients, God's precious gift of life. Help us to never see a person's productivity, physical dexterity, or mental acuity as the measure of the quality of their life. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

For those who are tempted to hasten their death through assisted suicide or euthanasia, give them courage to discuss their fears about suffering and dying with their loved ones. Equip those who provide counsel with wisdom based on your life-giving words and truth, so that all fears are brought to Jesus, the suffering servant they can trust. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

Father, by your grace, help us to revere and protect the lives of those who are silenced by age or illness, or who suffer intensely. May our devotion acknowledge your sovereignty over life and death, and the respect we offer reflect the sacred dignity of every human person. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen.**

I bid your prayers for people with disabilities, and those who are suffering, sick, troubled, weak, terminally ill, or dying, that they may be granted the joy of salvation and the comfort of the Holy Spirit.
