

## AM I READY?

Before you commit to leading life ministry in your church, we recommend self-evaluation and reflection in addition to church leadership approval.

### 1. Pray

Seek God's guidance as you make the decision to pursue serving God's Kingdom for life.

### 2. Discern

As you pray, consider your walk with the Lord, your calling, your leadership skills, and your time availability.

### 3. Approval

Since all new church ministries should have approval of the church's leadership, AFL requires that as well.

### 4. Request

Contact AFL to request the relevant resources to get started.

## Appoint a Life Leader

Life Leaders serve as the dedicated point person between their church and Anglicans For Life. In this role, you'll organize, plan, and lead Life-Affirming activities, initiatives, and ministry within your church. Becoming a Life Leader is a powerful way to deepen your faith, become a change-maker in your church, and gain meaningful leadership experience that equips your congregation to walk alongside those facing life-and-death challenges.

## Become a Life-Affirming Church

Anglicans For Life wants to build partnerships with churches that recognize and uphold the Sanctity of Life in both the Word they preach and in the Life-Affirming ministry, education, and the Biblical advocacy they offer to parishioners and members of the community. All Life-Affirming Churches (LAC) adopt the Anglicans For Life Declaration of Life Statement.

## Establish an AFL Chapter

AFL Chapters are formed when a group of believers come together with a shared desire to uphold the dignity of every human life through education, advocacy, and compassionate ministry. Every Chapter is unique—shaped by the specific needs, gifts, and calling of its local community. Whether your Chapter feels called to focus on beginning-of-life topics or to care for the elderly, the goal remains the same: honoring God by valuing every life He has created. No matter how God leads your Chapter, your primary responsibility is to seek His guidance and direction as you develop your Chapter's ministry, education, and outreach efforts.
